THIS CONTRACT for the personal services of musicians, made this 10 (Ten) day of December, 19 61 between the undersigned employer (hereinafter called the "employer") and 10 (Ten) musicians (including the leader) (hereinafter called "employees").

WITNESSETH, That the employer hires the employees as musicians severally on the terms and conditions below, and as further specified on reverse side. The leader represents that the employees already designated have agreed to be bound by said terms and conditions. Each employee yet to be chosen shall be so bound by said terms and conditions upon agreeing to accept his employment. Each employee may enforce this agreement.
